Day 01: 22ND MARCH, KOLKATA – DELHI

By Flight

Meal on Board

Welcome to Smiles Per Miles Pvt. Ltd. Embark on a journey with us to one of the most demanding destinations of the world named Iceland & Arctic Lapland. Arrive at Kolkata airport to board the flight to Delhi under the guidance of our Tour Manager.

Reach Delhi at night and wait to board the next connecting flight from Delhi to Helsinki.

Day 02: 23RD MARCH, DELHI – HELSINKI

By Flight & Road AY 122 07:50 / 14:10 HRS.

Meals: Meal on Board & Indian Dinner

In the early morning, complete all the immigration formalities at Delhi airport and board the flight to Helsinki.

Reach Helsinki in the afternoon. After completing all immigration formalities, hop on to the coach and proceed to the hotel for check-in. Freshen up and relax for some time. Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and stay overnight in the hotel at Helsinki.

Day 03: 24TH MARCH, HELSINKI – KEFLAVIK

KEFLAVIK – GOLDEN CIRCLE TOUR – HELLA

Meals: Packed Breakfast & Local Dinner

Check-out early from the hotel with packed breakfast and proceed to Helsinki airport to board the flight to Keflavik.

Arrive at Keflavik International Airport. **WELCOME TO ICELAND** – the landscape is varied, rough but at the same time romantic with steep cliffs plunging precipitously into narrow fjords, deep canyons, extensive glaciers, black sand-beaches, grumbled volcanos and boiling geysers. After collecting your baggage, board the luxury coach and proceed for the **GOLDEN CIRCLE** tour.

First, proceed to **Thingvellir National Park** – the only place on Earth where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates are exposed above the sea level. It's sheer aesthetic beauty surrounded by a bowl of ancient mountain peaks, dried magma fields covered in Icelandic moss and carved by glacial springs make it one of the most visited spots in Iceland. It is home to the glacial spring Silfra fissure. It is here that the world's first democratically elected parliament, Alþingi, was formed in 930 AD. Next, visit **Strokkur**, a fountain geyser located in a geothermal area beside the Hvítá River in **Haukadalur Valley** of Iceland in the south-west part of the country. Strokkur, like all hot geysers, is caused by water meeting magma-heated rock, then boiling and erupting under pressure. This magnificent geyser spurt water up to 50m in the air and reliably erupts every five to 10 minutes.

Then, visit **Gullfoss** meaning 'golden waterfall' that owes its name to the rainbow that paints the sky above the water as soon as the sun comes out. The Hvítá rushes into a ravine, its flanks tall basaltic organs, to form the Gullfoss waterfall that cascades over two huge shelves for a total drop of 32 meters and is 70 meters wide. Later, check-in to the hotel followed by local dinner and stay overnight in Hella.

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Day 04: 25TH MARCH, HELLA – ICELAND'S SOUTH COAST TOUR – HELLA
By Road
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

Today after breakfast, proceed to visit **Skogafoss**. Skogafoss, or “forest falls,” is formed by the Skóga River rushing over the Fimmvörðuháls Pass as it melts away from the Eyjafjallajökull and Mýrdalsjökull glaciers. Located between these two majestic glaciers, Skogafoss can be seen from afar when you pass on the ring road and is a must-see attraction for all tourists visiting southern Iceland. The Skóga River tumbles from the top of a 60-meter cliff over a 25-meter wide lip and smashes to the ground with a constant roar and cloud of mist: this is the mighty Skogafoss. Like other waterfalls in Iceland, Skogafoss is sometimes adorned with a beautiful rainbow as was the backdrop of the shooting spot of the song “Gerua” from the film “Dilwale” starring Shahrukh Khan and Kajol.

Then, you can opt for the optional tour of **Sólheimasandur Plane Wreck** (optional - additional cost). It is the remains of a US Navy Douglas C-117D plane that made an emergency landing on a South Iceland black sand beach on November 21, 1973, after experiencing severe icing, with all seven crew members surviving. After the crash, the plane was left and for decades, it served as a raven's nest and a model for local photographers who have always enjoyed capturing the wreckage in different lights and seasons. The black sand beach and the stellar scenery makes the location look like something from another planet. It's not surprising that the Solheimasandur DC-3 plane wreck has been used in quite a few commercials, documentaries, a Bollywood film (Dilwale) and Justin Bieber's video for the song *I'll show you* in 2015.

Next, journey along the **southern coast of Iceland** to the world-famous black sand beach of Iceland – **REYNISFJARA**. With its dark and mysterious beauty, Reynisfjara beach offers a unique experience unlike anything else in the world. From the haunting sea stacks and the hexagonal basalt columns to the rolling waves and the incredible birdlife, it is a destination on every traveller's bucket-list. Observe the rocky sea stacks sitting off the shoreline, known as Reynisdrangar and then stop at **VIK** for some time.

Next, proceed towards the famous **Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon**, one of the most incredible natural wonders of the world. People are often blown away by the sheer vastness and unique beauty before them, as majestic icebergs make their way through the enormous lagoon to the Atlantic Ocean.

After leaving the lagoon, the glistening blue and white icebergs are washed up on the black sandy coastline at **Diamond Beach**, another iconic stop in the area. While many of the icebergs go straight out into the ocean, the chunks that wash up at the beach glisten in contrast to the dark sand. This creates a vision unlike you will see anywhere else in the world.

Then, return to the hotel followed by local dinner and stay overnight in Hella.



Day 5: 26TH MARCH, HELLA – GRUNDARFJÖRÐUR – KIRKJUFELL – REYKJAVÍK
Meals: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

Have breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to **Seljalandsfoss**. Then journey towards **Kirkjufell** through an amazing landscape. Particularly photogenic, this mountain is simply the most photographed site in Iceland along with **Kirkjufellsfoss**. Kirkjufell can be translated from Icelandic as “the church mountain”, explained most probably by its particular pyramid structure. It is found on the north coast of the **Snæfellsnes Peninsula** near **Grundarfjörður**. Located right on the seashore, the mountain rises 463 meters from the waterline, as if planted in the ocean. Famously, it was one of the filming locations for season 7 of the famous *Game of Thrones* series and called “Arrow Head Mountain” in the fantasy world.

The mountain is in fact made up of stratified sedimentary rock chronicling the various ice ages and eruptions of the Lýsuskarð volcanic system. Finally, the summit is made of tuff, a rock formed by the accumulation of volcanic projections. You can clearly see the different layers on the mountain when you are nearby.

Then, proceed to the Icelandic capital – **REYKJAVÍK** for a guided city tour including Hallgrímskirkja, Sun Voyager Sculpture on the Atlantic Waterfront, Lighthouse, Harpa Concert Hall or Opera House, Reykjavík Pond, City Hall, Rainbow Street etc. Have Indian dinner in the restaurant and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Reykjavík.

Day 6: 27TH MARCH, KEFLAVÍK – HELSINKI
Meal: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

After an early breakfast, proceed to Keflavik airport to board the flight to Helsinki. Reach Helsinki in the afternoon. Hop on to the coach and proceed to the hotel for check-in. Freshen up and relax for some time.

Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and stay overnight in the hotel at Helsinki.

Day 7: 28TH MARCH, HELSINKI – PORVOO – HELSINKI – SANTA CLAUS EXPRESS
Meals: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a guided city tour of **Porvoo**.

Walk through the narrow cobblestone streets that are lined up with charming cafes, restaurants, boutiques housed in historical wooden buildings of different colours. Visit the red wooden warehouses along the river that dates back hundreds of years and are the town's landmark.

Later, return to **Helsinki** and proceed for an **orientation tour of the city** including **Sibelius Monument, Helsinki Senate Square, Helsinki Cathedral** etc.



Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and proceed to Helsinki Central Railway Station to board the **double-decker Santa Claus Express** for an overnight journey from Helsinki to Rovaniemi.

Day 08: 29TH MARCH, ROVANIEMI

Meals: Breakfast on board & Indian Dinner

Have breakfast on board in the bistro of Santa Claus Express as we travel through the wintry landscapes passing through the towns and forests with snow-capped trees. In the morning, arrive at Rovaniemi, the official hometown of Santa Claus and start experiencing the magic of winter in Lapland.

Then, proceed to **Ranua Arctic Zoo** which is home to Finland's only polar bear and 50 other arctic and northern animal species in the middle of arctic coniferous forests.

Next, proceed towards **Santa Claus Village** which is the doorstep of Santa himself along with the elves, the Arctic Circle and the Finnish winter wonderland. Experience the joy of meeting Santa Claus in Lapland's official Christmas village, located in the charming town of Rovaniemi. Meet the jolly Santa and chat with him, share your Christmas wishes and capture the moment with memorable photos. The village is open all year, so enjoy a unique Christmas experience no matter when you visit.

Soak up the magical festive atmosphere in this unique Christmas-themed village. Visit the Santa Claus Main Post Office, cross the Arctic Circle line and explore the local shops. Wander through the charming streets filled with magical decorations, unique shops and delightful cafés. Capture the magic against the beautiful backdrop of the Arctic wilderness, including the iconic Arctic Circle line. You can also enjoy a reindeer sleigh ride at your own cost, if you wish.

In the evening, Santa Claus Village transforms into a magical, glowing landscape, particularly during the winter months (December–March) when the "Kaamos" (Polar Night) brings long, dark nights. The area is illuminated by thousands of fairy lights, creating a warm, festive atmosphere against the snow-covered buildings, trees and paths.

Enjoy **Husky sled** (Optional package Cost for dog sledding) where you can feel Lapland's beauty and the purity of the natural environment. Fall in love with the winter wilderness where all you can hear is the panting of the dogs and the swish of the runners.

Next, have dinner in an Indian restaurant at Santa Claus Village and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay at Rovaniemi.

Later, proceed for aurora hunting and if you are lucky, you can view aurora borealis tonight. Return to the hotel and stay overnight.

Day 8



Day 09: 30TH MARCH, ROVANIEMI – KIRUNA
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Rovaniemi and journey towards Kiruna.

Reach Kiruna and visit **Jukkasjärvi Ice Hotel** which features rooms, icebar, church and other art exhibitions entirely made out of sculptured ice and snow from the neighboring Torne River. The building process starts in spring when massive blocks of ice are harvested from Torne River. Each block weighs up to two tons and is stored cold during the summer, ready for the winter and the construction of Ice Hotel.

In addition to ice, "snice" (a mix of snow and ice) is also used for building the hotel's floors, walls, and ceilings. Snice is not only beautiful to look at but also durable and reliable, making it ideal for creating the impressive structures of the Ice Hotel. For many of the artworks, light plays a crucial role in creating the final experience. The light adds an extra dimension that makes each sculpture tell its own story. It's a symbiosis between art and light, where every beam helps create the unique feeling that makes each room its own work of art.

Check-in to the hotel, have dinner and proceed for aurora hunting by the Torne River or any other area.

Day 9

Day 10: 31ST MARCH, KIRUNA – ABISKO – NARVIK
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Kiruna including a visit to Kiruna Church, once voted as the most beautiful old building in the country. The cosy terracotta-coloured church, with its fairy-tale rooftop points, is designed to resemble a hut of the indigenous Sami people.

Located in Swedish Lapland, explore the old town and the new town through the snow-blanketed streets along with the town hall where the buildings are being relocated because of the subsidence from the local iron ore mine that is threatening to swallow the town. It is billed as the world's most radical relocation project. Kiruna is the home to the world's largest iron-ore mine, opened in 1898 and still in use.

Next, journey towards **Abisko National Park** – a classic region in the heart of Lapland's alpine region.

Later, proceed towards Narvik. Its location is spectacular, pinched by islands to the west and mountains in every other direction, while spectacular fjords stretch north and south.

Check-in to the hotel at Narvik and have local dinner.

Later, proceed for aurora hunting and if you are lucky, you can view aurora borealis tonight. Return to the hotel and stay overnight.

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Day 11: 01ST APRIL, NARVIK – TROMSØ

Meals: Breakfast & Local/Indian Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed for a **guided city tour of Narvik**. Surrounded by mountains and fjords, this city provides a spectacular natural playground for visitors to explore. Visit Narvikfjellet - one of the most famous ski resorts in Northern Norway that provides stunning views and challenging treks. The mountain that towers above the city offers panoramic views of the peaks beyond, the city below, and the fjords snaking out to the open ocean. Next, visit Narvik Church, Narvik Port, Narvik Railway station from where the Arctic Train runs on selected days to Sweden and a historic locomotive is housed within. Visit Fiskehallen where you can experience the traditional Arctic Cuisine - fresh, traditional & modern. The Narvik region has in recent years established itself as a food destination with varied restaurants and some of the region's best wilderness chefs.

Next, proceed towards Tromsø. Tucked above the Arctic Circle, it is coined as the gateway to the Arctic. It is one of the best places in the world to see the northern lights. Tromsø is a part of a rich history of arctic exploration surrounded by mountains and beautiful fjords. It also houses the world's northernmost university.

On arrival, take the **Fjellheisen Gondola** to the top of Mount Storsteinen to enjoy panoramic views over buzzing Tromsø. **(Optional tour cost)**

Later, check-in to the hotel and have dinner.

Next, proceed for aurora hunting and if you are lucky, you can view aurora borealis tonight. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 12: 02ND APRIL, TROMSØ – ALTA
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

Today have a relaxed breakfast in the hotel. After breakfast, proceed for a **city tour of Tromsø** including the Arctic Cathedral, Tromsø Cathedral, Tromsø Library, Harbour etc. Tromsø is a city best explored on foot. The city offers a mix of cultural events, museums, outdoor activities and restaurants that serve arctic delicacies. There are many interesting museums, art galleries and experience centres within walking distance of the city centre.

After the tour, proceed towards **Alta** and visit the Northern Lights Cathedral from outside.

On arrival, check-in to the hotel. Have a delicious local dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay in Alta.

Later, proceed for aurora hunting and if you are lucky, you can view aurora borealis tonight.



Day 13: 03RD APRIL, ALTA – HAMMERFEST – HONNINGSVÅG
By Road
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Alta and proceed towards Hammerfest, the northernmost town of the world on the barren island of Kvaløya on the north western coast of Norway.

Enjoy a **guided city tour of Hammerfest** including a visit to **The Royal and Ancient Polar Bear Museum**. Being the gateway to the Barents Sea and the Arctic Ocean, Hammerfest is one of the most widely visited places in northern Norway.

Next, begin your journey and enjoy a scenic drive towards **Honningsvåg** – a charming Arctic town, where the **Midnight Sun shines** and the **Northern Lights dance**. Honningsvåg is situated at a bay on the southeastern side of the large island of Magerøya, while the famous North Cape and its visitor center are on the northern side of the island. Honningsvåg is a port of call for Hurtigruten Coastal Express and cruise ships, especially in the summer months. The ice-free ocean (the southwestern part of the Barents Sea) provides rich fisheries, stop for Nordic gas and oil industry and tourism is also important to the town. Five degrees north of the Arctic Circle and the northernmost city in mainland Norway, Honningsvåg is a warm and welcoming refuge where the landscape opens toward the vast ocean, offering insight into how nature and the sea have been the lifeline of generations.

Visit the **North Cape Museum** which is a local cultural heritage museum presenting the history of the island of Magerøya and its population, from the Stone Age to Modern Times. It is dedicated to inform about the first settlers in the region, the daily life on the island and the reconstruction of Honningsvåg after the city was burned to the ground during the Second World War. The permanent exhibition also covers the fishing and marine development of the region. The Museum also regularly holds temporary art exhibitions by local and international artists.

Check-in to the hotel at Honningsvåg, have local dinner and proceed for aurora hunting. Later, return to the hotel and stay overnight.

Day 13

Day 14: 04TH APRIL, HONNINGSVÅG – NORTH CAPE – IVALO – SAARISELKA (GLASS IGLOO)
By Road
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

After a relaxed breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Alta.

Travel through spectacular scenery with fjords, endless ocean and cliff coasts. On the way, pass by a charming fishing village, a traditional seaside boathouse, Sami family, reindeers in their natural habitat. We'll stop at a scenic viewpoint with breath-taking fjord views. This is your first chance to see the **North Cape** and the historic Hornvika, the original gateway to this famous destination. Next, head up to the **North Cape Plateau**, rising 307 meters above the sea. Feel the thrill of standing at the northernmost point of Europe.

Encounter the iconic **Globe Monument**, dramatic cliffs and panoramic views of the Barents Sea. The North Cape reveals itself as the wild, raw and powerful place and one of the world's most famous lookout points. Return across the open mountain

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plateau before arriving back in Honningsvåg. Visit the arctic town of Honningsvåg with its church and its preserved fishing facility near the harbour where you can explore a photo gallery, browse for souvenirs and reflect on the rich history of Arctic fishing communities.

Next, proceed towards Saariselka via **Ivalo**. En-route, stop at **Lake Inari**, the frozen and the third largest lake in Finland.

Later, proceed to Saariselka and stay in a **glass igloo**. Enjoy a delicious local dinner in the hotel followed by an overnight stay in the igloo.

Experience a night under the stars at glass roofed accommodation and if you are lucky enough, you can view the aurora borealis or the northern lights from glass igloo tonight.

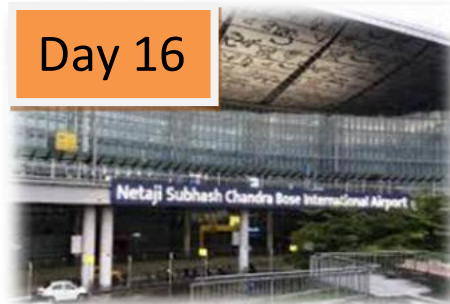
