Discover the widely branching rivers and the rue of nature in a traditional and relaxed way by Spreewald barge in a group boat tour. A boat trip offers the opportunity to experience the beauty of Spreewald to the fullest. Sit back and relax as the bargemen takes you on a journey through the winding waterways. The slow glide on the calm water allows you to admire the unspoilt nature, the diverse flora and fauna as well as the charming and quaint Spreewald houses from a unique perspective. Next, drive through **Linz** and proceed to **Salzburg** - the city of Sound of Music. It is one of Europe's most beautiful cities, both for its architecture and for its magnificent setting. This picturesque city stretches along both banks of the River Salzach as it emerges from the Salzburg Alps. On arrival, meet a local English-speaking guide and proceed for a **guided walking city tour including the Mirabell Gardens and Palace, Love's Lock Bridge on the Salzach River, Pegasus Fountain, Fortress Hohensalzburg, Salzburg Cathedral, Schloss Hellbrunn, Mozart's residence and Mozartplatz** (all outside view). First, proceed for **Hallstatt Funicular and Skywalk** (subject to operation on the day of visit – optional cost applicable). Enjoy a **boat trip** on Lake Hallstätter See and enjoy the tranquility and sublime views. Visit the Hallstatt **panoramic viewpoint, waterfall, Evangelical Christ Church** in Hallstatt, **Marktplatz** and stroll around in the streets of this charming village and enjoy its dramatic alpine setting of 16th-century Alpine houses and alleyways that are home to cafes and shops.

The Austrian lakeside towns of Hallstatt, Obertraun, Altaussee, Grundlsee, Mondsee, Bad Goisern, Bad Ischl and Bad Aussee form the Salzkammergut region, set amid exquisitely beautiful mountain scenery with picture-perfect lakes. It is an area of spectacular natural beauty in the center of incredible Austria. The lakes with impressive mountain drop is one of the most beautiful sights you'll see.

Next, proceed to check-in to the hotel in a small, charming town located in the Salzkammergut region.

Day 06: 31ST MAY, SALZKAMMERGUT REGION – VIENNA

Next, visit the **Palace and Gardens of Schönbrunn** which is outstanding as one of the most impressive and well-preserved Baroque ensembles of its kind in Europe. Additionally, it is a potent material symbol of the power and influence of the House of Habsburg over a long period of European history, from the end of the 17th to the early 20th century. It is impossible to separate the gardens from the palace; of which they form an organic extension. This is an excellent example of the concept of Gesamtkunstwerk, a masterly fusion of many art forms.

Next, proceed for a **guided city tour of Vienna** including **St. Stephen's Cathedral, outside view of Hofburg Palace, Belvedere Palace, City Hall, Austrian Parliament, Judenplatz Holocaust Memorial, Column of Pest, Maria-Theresien-Platz, Opera House, Ringstrasse, Stadpark** (all from outside).

Have dinner in an Indian restaurant and check-in to the hotel at Vienna.



Day 07: 1ST JUNE, VIENNA – BRATISLAVA – BUDAPEST
Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel at Vienna and proceed to Bratislava – the capital and the largest city of Slovakia. Enjoy a guided walking tour of the city. Start with **Hviezdoslavovo Square** and discover the Opera House and Reduta Building. Admire the Man Work statue in the city's Main Square. Pause at the Roland fountain and hear the legend of the knight Rowland. Take a photo with a Napoleonic soldier as you pass by the Old Town Hall. Stroll through Primate's square to Franciscan Square. Marvel at one of Bratislava's hidden gems: Primate's Palace. Take in the stunning Micheal's Gate. See the palace where the Hungarian Parliament used to meet. End the walking portion of your tour at the gates of St. Martin's Cathedral. Continue to drive by the Presidential Palace in Palisady District, which was built in the functionalist style. Visit **Bratislava Castle** and see the Slovak Government building, Most SNP, Devan Castle etc. Finish your tour with a visit to the Slavin Monument, where you can enjoy a superb view over all of Bratislava. Then, proceed to Budapest, the Hungarian capital and the second largest city on River Danube.

In the evening, enjoy **Folklore Hungarian Dance show along with local dinner in the restaurant**. This authentic folk show will provide entertainment from one of the top ensembles in the country.

Day 08: 2ND JUNE, BUDAPEST
Meals: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a guided city tour of Budapest. Pass by the **Parliament building** and the **Margaret Bridge** on the Danube and drive to the **Royal Castle** on the Buda side of the city. Enjoy free time as you visit the **Fisherman's Bastion**. Spend some time in **Andrasi Avenue** and see the **Basilica of St. Stephen, Castle District, Heroes Square, Chain Bridge and Matthias Church** known for its neo-gothic and neo-Romanesque architecture. From the towers and the terrace, a panoramic view exists of Danube, Margaret Island, pest to the east and the Gellért Hill.

In the evening, enjoy the romantic **Duna Bella Cruise** on River Danube for an hour. Board a wonderful cruise and marvel at the evening sights and history of the nearby attractions of the guided Budapest River cruise boat, Duna Bella, the panorama boat of the Legenda fleet. Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and check-in to the hotel at Budapest for an overnight stay.

Day 09: 3RD JUNE, BUDAPEST – DONOVALY – WIELICZKA – KRAKOW
Meals: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Budapest, Hungary and proceed towards Krakow, a city in southern Poland, via Donovaly in Slovakia.

On the way, pass through **Donovaly**, a small yet charming mountain village nestled in the heart of Slovakia, a popular tourist destination for skiing and snowboarding. It offers a captivating blend of natural beauty, cultural richness surrounded by breathtaking mountain peaks, stunning landscapes dotted with lush forests and pristine alpine meadows offering a perfect backdrop for travellers.



Known for its well-preserved medieval core, Jewish quarter, breathtaking sights and intriguing places, Krakow is the second largest and one of the oldest cities in Poland, situated on the Vistula River.

En-route, visit **Wieliczka Salt Mines**, one of the world's oldest salt mines in operation from the 13th century until 2007 producing table salt. Commercial mining was discontinued in 1996, because of salt prices going down and also mine flooding. The mine is currently one of Poland's official national historic monuments, whose attractions include dozens of statues and four chapels carved out of the rock salt by the miners, along with supplemental carvings made by contemporary artists.

Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Krakow.



Day 10: 4TH JUNE, KRAKOW – AUSCHWITZ – KRAKOW

Day 10
By Road

Meals: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a guided tour including visit to the **Old Town**, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1978, one of the world's first sites granted the status.

Then, visit Krakow Cloth Hall at Main Square and pass by Town Hall Tower, Krakow's Central Square and the Mickiewicz Monument, Kazmierz Former Jewish district, Florianska Street. Also visit **Wawel Royal Castle (castle ground complex)**, **Monument of Pope John Paul II in Wawel Hill**, Wawel Cathedral, St. Peter and Paul Church, St. Florian's Church etc. from outside.



Next, drive to Auschwitz. On arrival at the **Auschwitz Concentration Camp**, take a guided tour of what was addressed as "The Hell On Earth".

The concentration camp in Auschwitz was established by Nazis on the outskirts of the town Oswiecim in 1940. After the war, the camp was turned into museum displaying evidence of the genocide. Block no. 11, known as the Death Block, was where people were murdered and also called the "Wall of Death". Outside the camp, there is a gas chamber, where approx. 70,000 people were killed.



In 1942-1945, approx. 1.5 million people lived and died here. 90% of them were the Jews; others were Poles, Gypsies, Russians and prisoners from 28 countries. Since 1944, transports of prisoners from all over the continent entered directly through the "Gate of Death". In 1979 Auschwitz – Birkenau Concentration Camp was listed a UNESCO World Culture and National Heritage Site.



Have dinner in an Indian restaurant and stay overnight in the hotel at Krakow.

Day 11: 5TH JUNE, KRAKOW – KIELCE – WARSAW

Meals: Breakfast & Indian Dinner

This morning after breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Krakow and proceed to Warsaw, the capital and largest city of Poland. On the way, enjoy a brief orientation tour of **Kielce**, a city in south eastern Poland lying in the Holy Cross Mountains, known for its historic architecture, green spaces, cathedral and parks.

On arrival, enjoy a guided walking city tour of Warsaw. Enjoy a photo stop at **Monument to the Ghetto Heroes, Chopin Monument, Copernicus Statue, Wilanow Palace, King Sigismund's III Column** located at **Castle Square, Palace of Culture, Lazienki Palace, Warsaw Uprising Monument, Warsaw's Old Town**, where the **Royal Castle** is located, **Archcathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist**, one of the most important churches in Warsaw, **Umschlagplatz**, one of the most heartbreaking places in Warsaw - on this square, Nazis loaded Jewish people into carriages and transported them to Treblinka concentration camp. Journey along the "**Royal Route**" admiring the aristocratic residences and famous monuments. Pass through the UNESCO World Heritage-designated **Old Town Market Square, Castle Square**, and the **Praga District**. Admire the "**Palace on the Water**," the lavish summer residence of the last King of Poland, Stanislaw August Poniatowski and The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Witness the **Presidential Palace and Warsaw University buildings**.

Later, have dinner in an Indian restaurant and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay in Warsaw.


Day 12: 6TH JUNE, WARSAW – KOLKATA

After an early breakfast, proceed to Warsaw airport to board the flight from Warsaw to Kolkata.

Board the connecting flight to Kolkata.
