#### ADDIS ABABA – SAO PAULO

Arrive at Addis Ababa and then proceed to board the onward flight to Sao Paulo - the biggest city of South American continent.

**Welcome to Brazil.** After clearing customs and completing all immigration formalities, meet our local personnel at Sao Paulo International Airport (GRU) and then proceed to the hotel. São Paulo – Brazil's vibrant financial center, an alpha global city is known for its iconic buildings ranging from neo-Gothic cathedral to modernist skyscrapers. On arrival, check-in to the hotel. Freshen up, relax and take rest. Later, have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight in the hotel at Sao Paulo.

### Day 03: 19<sup>th</sup> August, SAO PAULO

#### Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Wake up and have a wonderful morning breakfast. Then, set out to explore the city of Sao Paulo in an orientation tour. Get started with the **Luz railway station**, with its unique 19th-century architecture and a tradition as one of the most-visited landmarks in the city. Visit **Cathedral Sao Paulo**. Next, see imposing buildings in the historical part of the city, such as the **Edifício Itália**, one of the tallest skyscrapers in Brazil, and the Municipal Theatre.

Stop by the **Liberdade neighborhood**, home to Sao Paulo's largest number of Japanese immigrants and featuring a unique décor. After enjoying the historic part of the town, make your way to the modern side of the town. Start with the **Paulista** region and see the main financial center, attractions such as **the MASP Museum** and luxury streets like **Oscar Freire**. Stop at **Avenida Paulista, Stadium Morumbi and the University of Sao Paulo**.

Finally, head to the largest park in Sao Paulo, **Ibirapuera Park**, with its nearly 250 acres (100 hectares) of green area, museums designed by Oscar Niemeyer and monuments such as the **Bandeirantes Monument** where you can take some outstanding photos. Later, enjoy a sumptuous dinner and stay overnight in Sao Paulo.

**Day 04: 20<sup>th</sup> August, SAO PAULO – LIMA**

**By Flight & Road**

**Meals: Packed Breakfast & Dinner**

Check-out early in the morning and proceed to Sao Paulo airport to board the flight to Lima. Packed breakfast box will be served.

Arrive at Lima and transfer to the hotel for check-in to freshen up.

In the afternoon, proceed for **sightseeing tour of Colonial and Modern Lima** passing by outstanding monuments such as the **Government Palace, the City Hall and the Cathedral at the Plaza Mayor**. Visit the **Basilica and Convent of San Francisco**, a must-see for its beautiful Baroque-style architecture. Visit the **Banco Central de Reserva Museum** which exhibits pre and post Columbian artifacts, jewellery and paintings. Before returning to the hotel, enjoy a short tour of the modern districts of **San Isidro and Miraflores** from where you can enjoy a magnificent view of the Pacific Ocean. Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Lima.



**Day 5: 21<sup>st</sup> August, LIMA – CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY**

**By Flight & Road**

**Meals: Packed Breakfast & Dinner**

Early in the morning, check-out from the hotel and proceed to Lima airport to board the flight to Cusco. Packed breakfast box will be served.

On arrival, leave for **city tour of Cusco**. This half-day tour of charming Cusco offers history, living culture and art to the visitors. We will be able to appreciate how the Andean and Spanish cultures, as well as the past and the present, coexist in harmony in the Imperial City. Visit the Temple of the Sun "**The Korikancha**", on top of which the Saint Dominique Convent was built. A legend tells that his temple was entirely lined in gold sheets that marvelled the Conquistadors upon their arrival. We will climb up the **Archaeological Park of Sacsayhuaman** and start our excursion visiting the fortress with the same name, a beautiful place that radiates peace, where we will be able to admire the huge rocks measuring up to 4 meters' high that were used in its construction. We will visit the archaeological center of **Kenko**, a ceremonial place where the sun, the moon and the stars were worshiped, then **Tambomachay** where we can view the sacred fountains of life and health. On the way, we will have a panoramic view from **Puca Pucara**, a watchtower that controlled the entrance to the city. The tour will end on reaching the hotel in the valley. Check-in to the hotel, have dinner & stay overnight in Sacred Valley.



**Day 6: 22<sup>nd</sup> August, SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU – CUSCO**

**By Road & Expedition train**

**Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

One of the most important tourist landmarks in the world awaits us: **Machu Picchu!** Our adventure will begin by boarding the train to Aguas Calientes, also known as **Machu Picchu Pueblo**, a picturesque town at the foot of the emblematic **Inca citadel**. During the train ride, we can enjoy the natural beauty of the surroundings, with impressive views of majestic mountains, the Vilcanota river and small towns of the Peruvian Andes; a visual feast that fills us with anticipation for the visit to the wonder that is Machu Picchu.

After a short bus ride from Aguas Calientes, we will find ourselves in front of one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World – an unforgettable sight!



From there, we will explore the ancient ruins, learning all about the history and mysteries that this mystical and impressive place holds. Surrounded by incomparable landscapes, there will be no shortage of spectacular photo opportunities! Once we have recharged ourselves with the magical energy of Machu Picchu, we will return to Aguas Calientes.

After the visit, enjoy lunch at the Sanctuary Lodge, located at the entrance of the citadel. Then, return to Cusco. Upon arrival, check-in to the hotel. Later, have dinner with show and stay overnight in Cusco.



**Day 07: 23<sup>rd</sup> August, CUSCO – RAINBOW MOUNTAIN – CUSCO**

**Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

Vinicunca or the **Rainbow Mountain** is one of the most popular destinations in Cusco. Today, in the early morning, set to discover the beauty of Rainbow Mountain in Peru, located in the Peruvian Andes, just 3 hours from the historical center of Cusco. The Rainbow Mountain Tour in Peru offers once-in-a-lifetime experience.

On our way, we will be able to observe the beautiful landscapes, canyons and beautiful glaciers as The Ausangate. Arrive at the Rainbow Mountain (5.020m / 16.466 ft.). Enjoy stunning view of the colorful hillside. The minerals that make up the mountain's soil give its slopes and summit colourful shades of red, purple, green, yellow, brown and pink, among other colours. After the tour, head towards Cusipata, where we will enjoy a refreshing traditional lunch.

Return to Cusco for dinner, followed by a relaxing stay in the hotel.

**Day 08: 24<sup>th</sup> August, CUSCO – PUNO**

**Meals: Breakfast & Dinner**

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel and proceed towards Puno enjoying the wonderful landscapes of the Southern Valley of Cusco on the way. Visit **Andahuaylillas**, where we will find the church of San Pedro, a beautiful 17th-century building that has an impressive organ, decorated with angels and cherubs. Then, we will visit the **Raqchi ruins**, also known as **The Temple of God Wiracocha** which have different areas that were used for various purposes. After the visit, we will head to **La Raya**, the highest point between Cusco and Puno, where we will make a short stop to appreciate the landscape. Before reaching our final destination, we will visit the site of **Pucara Museum**.

On arrival at Puno in the late afternoon, head straight to the hotel for check-in followed by dinner and an overnight stay in Puno.

**Day 09: 25<sup>th</sup> August, PUNO – LAKE TITICACA - PUNO**

After breakfast, proceed to **Lake Titicaca** which is home to unique communities with which we will share unforgettable moments learning about their culture and traditions. The Uros are a people who have lived on the floating islands of the lake for more than 3,000 years and their ancestral practices were declared Cultural Heritage of the Nation in 2013.

**Day 9**



In Taquile, we will witness another unique lifestyle of Lake Titicaca. As we hike to the top of the island, we can see different types of crops with the lake and the Illimani Mountain range in the background - a fascinating combination of green and blue. The residents of Taquile are known for their textile technique (declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO), where each colour and design captured on the fabric has a special meaning, permitting social co-existence. After touring the island and connecting with its customs, return to hotel. Enjoy a sumptuous dinner and stay overnight in Puno.



**Day 10: 26<sup>th</sup> August, PUNO – JULIACA – LIMA – SANTIAGO**

**Meals: Breakfast & Dinner**

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel and proceed to **Juliaca airport** to board the flight to Lima.

On arrival at Lima, board the connecting flight to Santiago.

Arrive at Santiago and proceed to the hotel for check-in followed by dinner and an overnight stay.

**Day 11: 27<sup>th</sup> August, SANTIAGO – VALPARAISO – VINA DEL MAR – SANTIAGO**

After breakfast, enjoy a full day tour to **Valparaiso and Vina del Mar**, lying on the coast of Chile. Travel through the wine growing region of **Casablanca Valley** before arriving to the coast. Valparaiso is the largest port in South America but with a small town feel in the town centre. Enjoy the **funicular railway** and some marvelous views of the distant **Andean Mountain range**. The tour continues onto the up-market resort town of Vina del Mar. Return to Santiago. Have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.

**Day 12: 28<sup>th</sup> August, SANTIAGO – BUENOS AIRES**

**Meals: Breakfast & Dinner**

After breakfast, proceed for the **city tour of Santiago**. Enjoy a visit of the neighbourhoods of Santiago. We start with a scenery tour in Providencia and the parks of this district. We then move on to Historical Downtown, where you will have a chance to see Santiago's traditional architecture. Our first visit will be to the **Santa Lucía hill**, you will have a panoramic view of the city, while enjoying the hill's vegetation and the architecture of Hidalgo's Castle.

After the tour, proceed to the airport to board the flight to Buenos Aires. Buenos Aires in Argentina, is the largest cosmopolitan capital city in the South American continent. It is famous for its phenomenal nightlife, which ranges from traditional neighbourhood taverns to award-winning cocktail bars, big club, and underground nightspots catering to every niche. On arrival at Buenos Aires, check-in to the hotel after dinner for an overnight stay.



### Day 13: 29<sup>th</sup> August, BUENOS AIRES CITY TOUR WITH TANGO SHOW

#### Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for the **city tour of Buenos Aires**, also referred to as the "Paris of South America". On an unforgettable route, we will live all the porteño magic. These few hours feature all the magic of Argentina's capital city. We will visit the glamorous neighborhoods of **Recoleta** and its most famous cemetery (entrance not included), **Palermo**, May Square and the Pink House, the Metropolitan Cathedral, the newest & trendiest **Puerto Madero** Area and many other emblematic buildings and palaces of unique architectural, historical, and cultural value. The visit would not be complete without the sights of the first settlements of the city of Buenos Aires. The picturesque neighbourhood of **San Telmo**, residence to the porteño aristocracy until the end of the XIX century, where the renowned antiques market is held every Sunday; Caminito Street, in the colourful, Italian immigrant's neighborhood of **La Boca**. In the evening, **enjoy dinner in a classic Buenos Aires theatre, followed by a night of Tango**. Piazzolla Tango is the Center for Art and Entertainment, with over three thousand square meters dedicated to the tango in the underground art nouveau General Guemes Gallery. After the show, return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

### Day 14: 30<sup>th</sup> August, BUENOS AIRES – IGUAZU FALLS (ARGENTINA SIDE)

#### Meals: Packed Breakfast & Dinner

In the early morning, check-out from hotel and proceed to the airport to board the domestic flight to Iguazu Falls.

On arrival, enjoy half-day **excursion of Iguazu Falls from Argentina side**. This falls is located 24 kilometers from downtown Foz do Iguazu. Iguazu National Park with a total of 55,500 hectares— bears the name of the river serving as northern border, which means "great waters" in the Guaraní language. Surrounded by lush subtropical rainforest, we will find the majestic Iguazu Waterfalls. Its water volume and more than 275 falls places it amongst the most important and spectacular waterfalls in the world. On different footbridges, we will visit the heart of the waterfalls, appreciating them from different angles. We will visit the **lower circuit** and feel part of nature, refreshing ourselves with waterfall drizzle. On the **upper circuit**, we will stop at different viewpoints, and then reach the **balcony at Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat)**. No doubt, this is the most amazing of all falls: water falls down from 80 meters. After the tour, check-in to the hotel followed by dinner and stay overnight.

### Day 15: 31<sup>st</sup> August, IGUAZU (BRAZIL SIDE) – RIO DE JANEIRO

#### Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and cross over to Brazil side.

On arrival at the Brazil side of the Iguazu Falls, enjoy **The Macuco Boat Ride**. It is the best way to complement our Iguazu Falls experience. After the tour, proceed to Foz do Iguazu airport to board the domestic flight to Rio de Janeiro. On arrival at Rio de Janeiro, proceed to the hotel for check-in after dinner and stay overnight.

**Day 16: 01<sup>st</sup> September, RIO DE JANEIRO**
**Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

After breakfast, proceed for a tour of Corcovado Mountain and Beaches. Board a cog train from Cosme Velho Station for a ride to Corcovado Mountain to visit one of the world's most famous landmarks, the gigantic statue of Christ the Redeemer. Experience 20 minutes' steep train journey which takes you through the dense Atlantic rainforest of Tijuca, offering a wonderful opportunity for a closer look at the forest's lush tropical vegetation and to enjoy scenic landscapes of the beaches and city. We will disembark at the top of Corcovado and then proceed up the steps that lead to the top lookout where the towering statue of Christ the Redeemer stands, one of the New 7 Wonders of the World. Get up-close to Christ the Redeemer and spend some time viewing the panoramic view of this beautiful city of Rio from the incredible mountain-top vantage point. Then, we will descend by the train. The tour continues passing by Rio's world-famous beaches. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon, proceed to the neighborhood of Urca where one of the largest symbols of the city is located: SugarLoaf Mountain. We will travel all the way to the top in two steps by cable car. The first cable car will take you to Urca Hill, a vantage point 215 meters high for which it grants beautiful views of Guanabara Bay and its islands, the Rio-Niterói Bridge, and Corcovado Mountain. From this stage, a second cable car takes you up to the top. At 395 meters, we will enjoy splendid views of Copacabana Beach, the Santa Cruz Fortress and several beaches of Niterói. Descend by the cable car and return to the hotel. In the evening, enjoy Samba Show. Later, have dinner and enjoy a comfortable overnight stay in Rio.

**Day 17: 2<sup>nd</sup> September, RIO DE JANEIRO – MANAUS – AMAZON**
**Meals: Breakfast & Dinner**

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and transfer to the airport to board the flight to Manaus. On arrival at Manaus, proceed to the pier and board the boat to get transferred to our Amazon lodge.

Check-in to the lodge. The day is free for some ecological activities offered by the lodge. Later, have dinner and stay overnight amidst Amazon rainforest.

**Day 18: 3rd September, AMAZON**

After breakfast, proceed for a morning trip to the unforgettable MEETING OF THE WATER, where the fast-moving black waters of the Rio Negro meet the slow-moving brown waters of the Rio Solimões to form the Amazon. These two waters run together for miles without mixing as differences in speed, temperature and composition keep them separate. It is an amazing spectacle to behold.

After a short rest, visit the home of local Amazonian residents "caboclos" with an opportunity for fishing. A bilingual guide will help you to learn about the traditions and customs of the local residents.

**Day 18**
